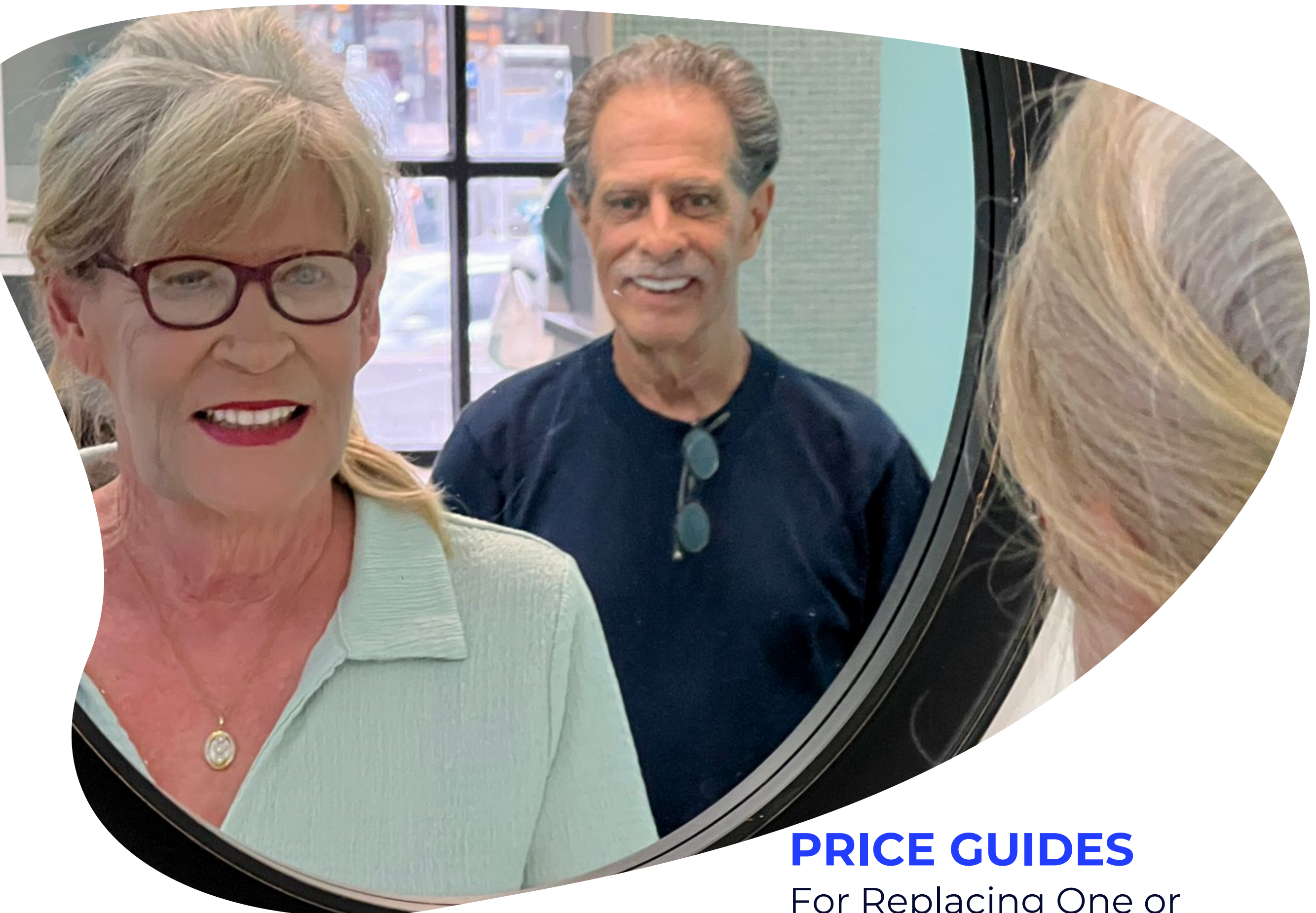

Price Guide For Replacing ALL of Your Teeth

These solutions are for you if you're embarrassed to smile, can't eat the foods you love or want to upgrade your loose dentures to something that looks and feels more natural.

Option 1 - COMPLEX Full Arch Implant Bridge

- Best for younger people with lots of remaining teeth and bone
- Requires 8 to 10 implants per jaw, which support a full set of porcelain crowns and bridges.
- Often requires bone grafting.
- Costs \$60K to \$70K per jaw, and can take 12-24 months.



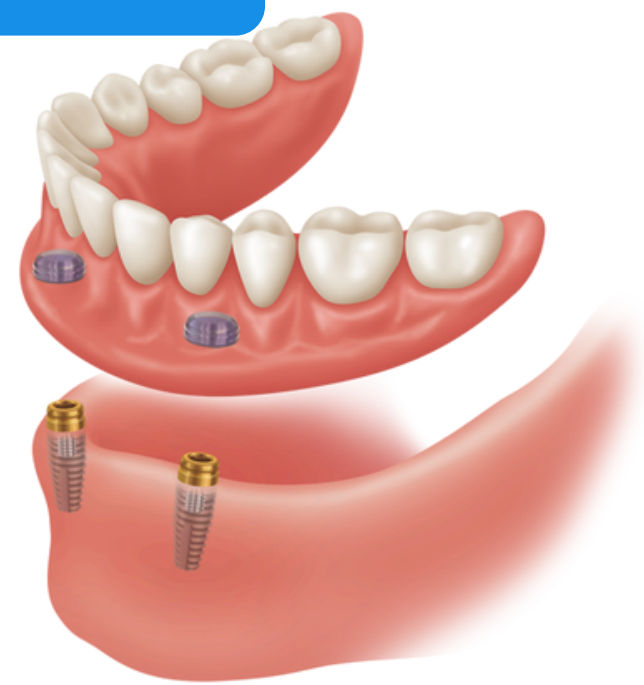
Option 2 - ALL-ON-4

- The most popular option today, since it looks and feels virtually the same as Option 1, but you save more than half the cost.
- There are multiple ways to do All-On-4 that differ in the number of implants, workflow, timing, and materials, they range in cost from \$20-\$28K.
- This is a more modern approach that only needs 4 implants instead of 8, so you can avoid major bone grafting and trips to the specialist office.
- NO grafting and NO loose dentures. Your new teeth are permanently secured on DAY ONE.
- The best part: It's all done in one office, with one doctor, in JUST ONE DAY.



Option 3 - REMOVABLE Implant Supported Snap-In Denture

- Good for people who want something way better than loose-fitting regular dentures, but can't afford the permanent, screwed-in options like the ones above.
- Requires 2 to 4 implants per jaw, which support a denture that snaps in and out.
- Cost is \$9K to \$12K for lower teeth, and \$20K-\$25K for upper teeth.



Option 4 - TRADITIONAL Complete Denture

- Cost is around \$2,500-\$6,000 (depends on remaining teeth)
- For people who want a quick fix to buy them some time.
- Held in by suction, gravity, and denture glue, so they slide and move when you eat, talk and smile.

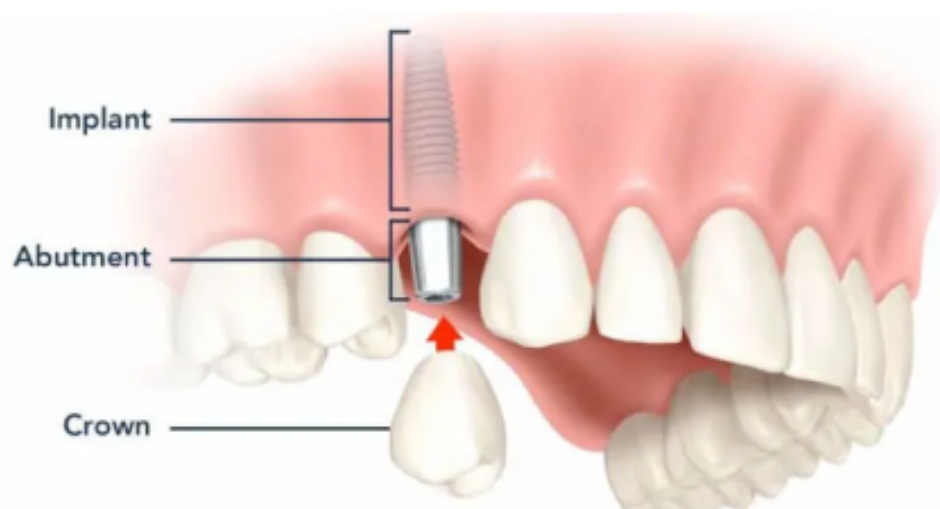


Price Guide for Replacing ONE OR TWO Missing Teeth

Do Nothing

Not all missing teeth need to be replaced. If you are not worried about chewing or appearance, then you might choose to leave the missing tooth alone. Keep in mind that if you do change your mind later, if you lose more bone it may be more difficult and more expensive than today.



Option 1: Dental Implant with Bone Reconstruction

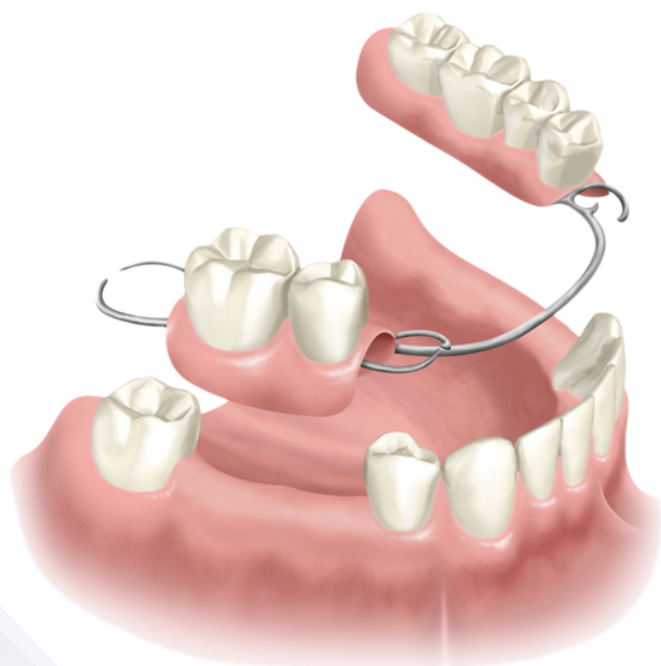
Implants are the strongest and longest lasting way to replace missing teeth...as long as you have enough bone. If you don't have enough bone, you may need to re-grow it first, which means extra bone grafting. In the end, you will probably spend \$5K - \$7K per tooth, and 12+ months.

Option 2: Regular Dental Implant

If your bone is in good condition already, and reconstruction is not needed, then the cost for an implant is around \$3,000 to \$5,500, saving you \$2,000 to \$4,000. And it can all be done in our office so you don't need to bounce around.

Option 3: Bridge

A bridge is a little less expensive than an implant (around \$4,000). The downside of a bridge is increased risk of cold sensitivity or even root canal problems. Bridges can also be difficult to clean and higher maintenance in the long run, and they don't last as long as implants.



Option 4: Removable Partial Denture

This is the cheapest and fastest option. It will cost \$1,000 to \$2,500 and take a couple of weeks. The problem is that they are removable, which means that they are not nearly as stable as the options above. You can't expect to eat or chew or grind your food very well, and you CAN expect to get food stuck around them, and to have metal hooks that might show in your smile. They are the cheapest, but this is definitely the least comfortable, functional, and desirable option.

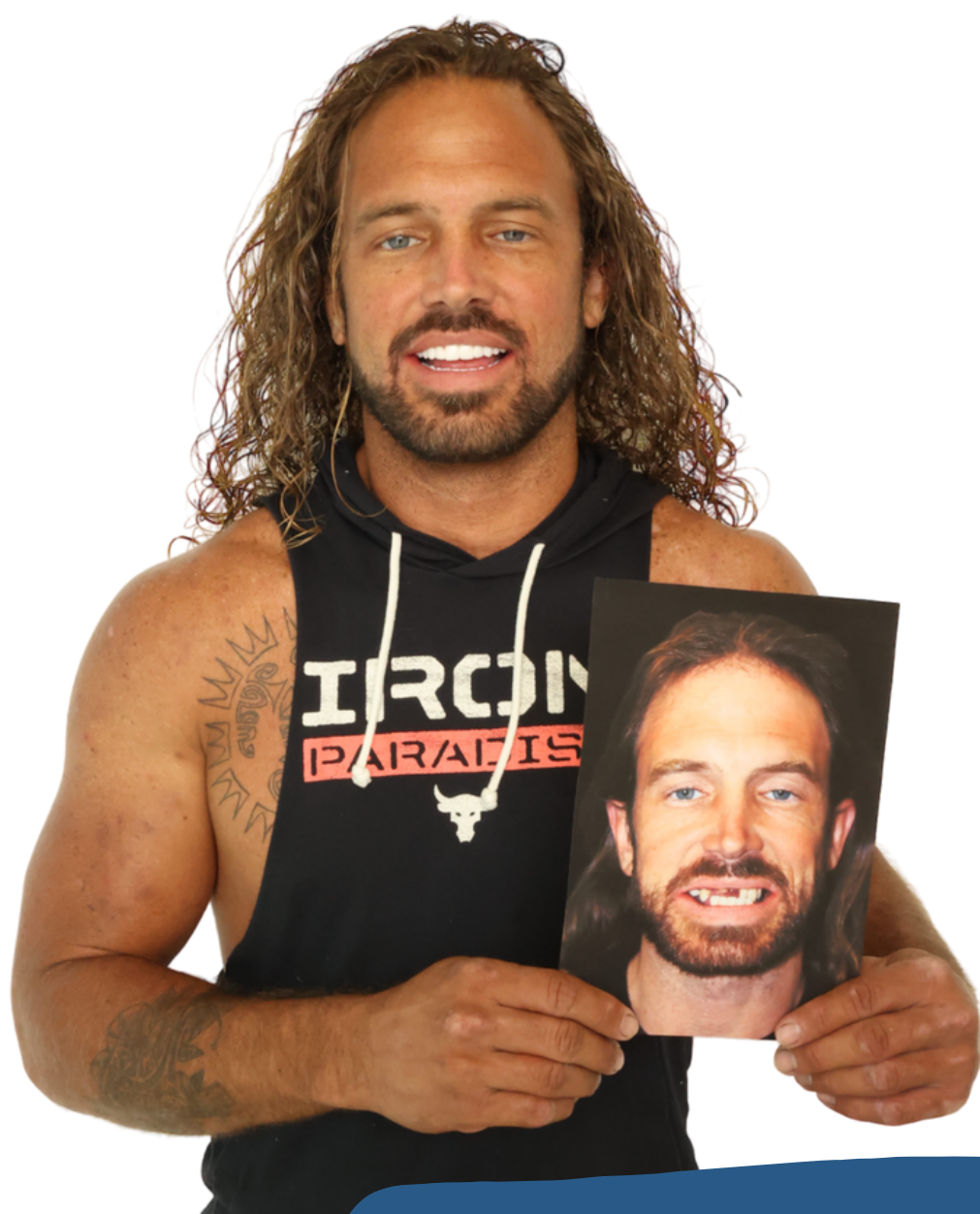

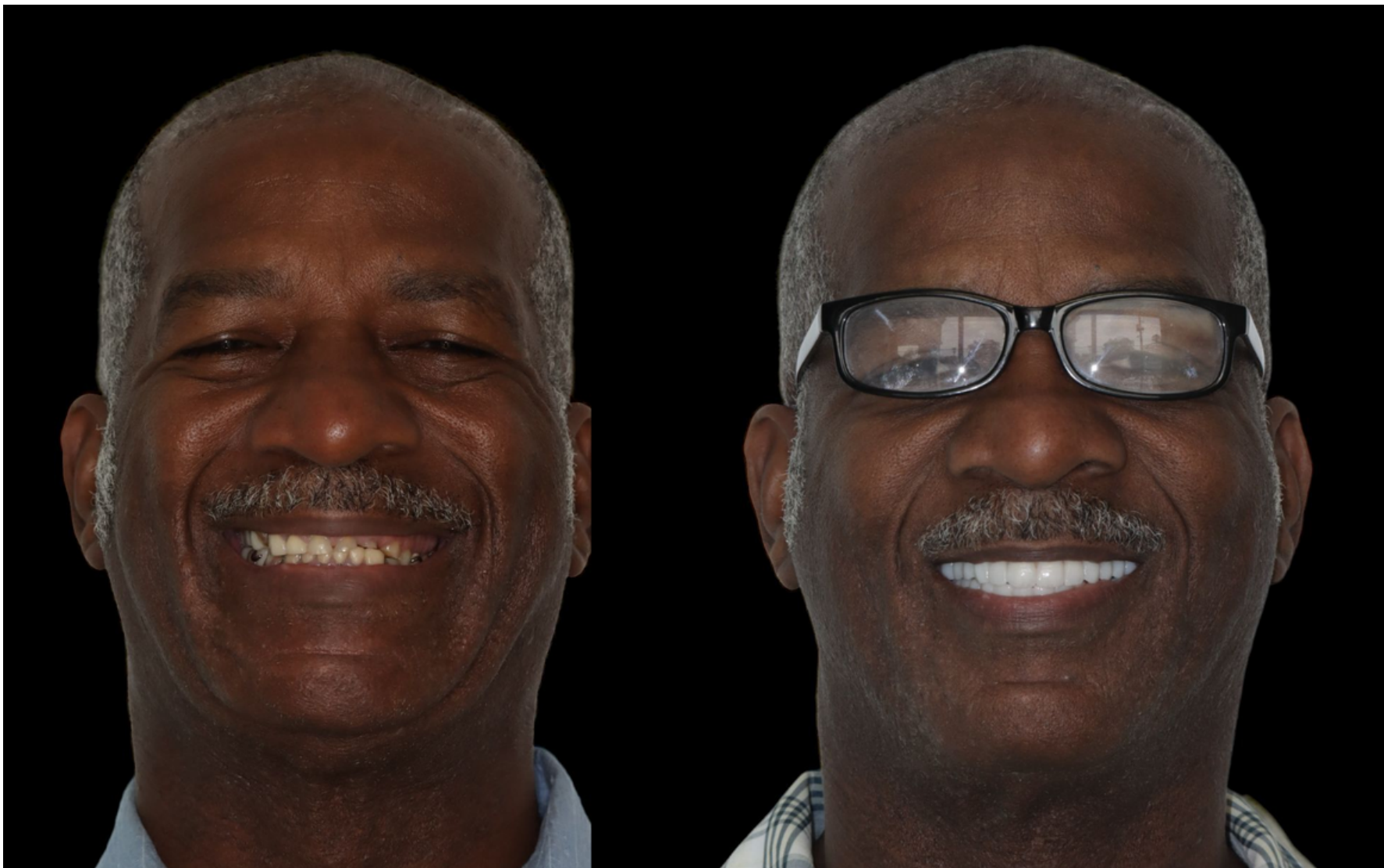
